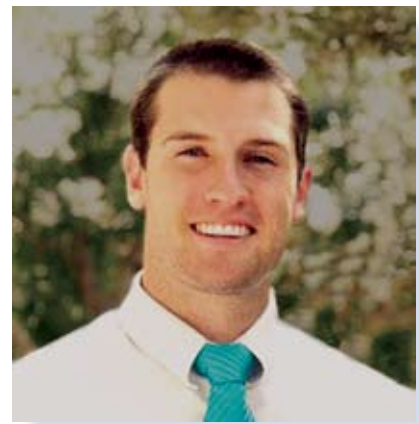




# MARAUDERS: BUILDING LEADERS

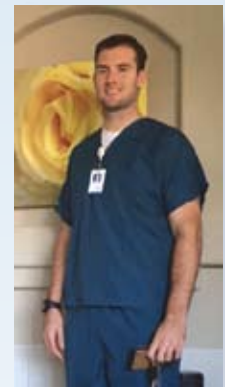
